



SHORT FILM COMPETITION

CORTO15'

The Monte Linas Library System and Sisar s.a.s. are proposing a short film competition aimed at primary and secondary schools in the associated municipalities (Arbus, Gonnosfanadiga, Guspini, Pabillonis, San Gavino Monreale, Sardara, Villacidro).

The short film, or short, is a film whose duration generally does not exceed 15 minutes, although Italian law allows it to last up to 75 minutes. Considered for a long time a minor genre compared to the film, today it has regained importance and consideration for its expressive capacity to develop a plot in a few minutes while keeping the viewer glued to the screen.

The theme of this competition is the narration of the library microcosm. Participants will have to tell, through a short film of a maximum length of 15 minutes, a story set in the library premises of the municipality in which their school is located. The library premises will be made available to the classes for filming, by previous arrangement with the librarian.

The library is primarily a place for the dissemination of culture, but over time it has also become a place for meeting, socialising, discussion and debate for adults, young people and children, a place of the present but also of the past and the future.

Participants will have a free choice of the film genre they would like to use to narrate the library, which can range from comedy to horror, drama to musical, comedy to detective story, and even a commercial...

The languages used may be Italian and/or Sardinian.

The short films participating in the competition will be published on the System's YouTube channel (Corto15 Sistema Bibliotecario Monte Linas) and can be voted on. The video with the most "likes" will receive a prize consisting of office supplies indicated by the winning class for a total expenditure of Euro 150.00 including VAT. In the event of a tie, the prize will be divided between the classes.

Each participating class will receive a certificate of participation.

REGULATION

The competition is aimed at primary and secondary schools located in the municipalities belonging to the Monte Linas Library System (Arbus, Gonnosfanadiga, Guspini, Pabillonis, San Gavino M.le, Sardara, Villacidro).

- Short films made in the school year 2022/2023 are eligible for the competition. The length of the films must not exceed 15 minutes (including opening and closing credits).
- Videos assembled with single images and slideshows are excluded.
- The format of the videos must be supported by Youtube.
- Participating classes must register for the competition by 15 October 2022 by filling in the registration form, which can also be downloaded from the FORM page of the www.bibliotechelinas.it website and sending it to corto15.montelinas@gmail.com after signing and scanning it.
- The films must be sent by 19 November to the e-mail address corto15.montelinas@gmail.com , using webtransfer or similar methods. The email must be accompanied by the release form (completed, signed and scanned) which can also be downloaded from the FORM page of the www.bibliotechelinas.it website.

- Registration for the competition is free of charge.
- Each participating class must indicate the name of a responsible teacher with contact details (email and/or telephone).
- The languages used may be Italian and/or Sardinian.
- The participating school (in the person of the legal representative or responsible teacher) assumes responsibility for the filmed material. The content of the works submitted in the competition must be in order with regard to the fulfilment of SIAE rights and current copyright legislation.

The Monte Linas Library System and Sisar s.a.s. decline all responsibility in this regard.

- All the short films received will be stored in a digital archive by the Monte Linas Library System. The participating short films will be screened during an event to which all the classes involved will be invited, at a date and place to be defined.
- The participating short films will be published on the System's YouTube channel (Corto15 Sistema Bibliotecario Monte Linas) and can be voted on. The video with the most "likes" will receive a prize consisting of stationery materials indicated by the winning class for a total expenditure of Euro 150.00 including VAT. In the event of a tie, the prize will be divided between the classes.
- Each participating class will receive a certificate of participation.
- Participation in the competition implies the acceptance and observance of all the rules contained in the present regulations and implies the granting of consent to the Monte Linas Library System to publish and screen the works received, with the mention of the intellectual property of the work, without time limits and without paying any royalties. All rights to the work are the property of the authors.
- The participating school undertakes to safeguard and guarantee the existence of the individual releases issued in accordance with the law by the parents of each minor taking part in the competition and of any other actor involved in any capacity in the filming, for the purpose of authorising the unreserved broadcasting of the filming involving them, and also undertakes to produce the same declarations at the simple request of the competition organiser.
